

**Future Trends in Environmental Philosophy
Boulder, Colorado**

The first annual meeting intended to bring together the environmental philosophy community will occur from June 1-4 at the Highlands Center, on the border of Rocky Mountain National Park 40 minutes from Boulder, Colorado. The meeting, sponsored by CU's Policy Center, will bring together the *International Association for Environmental Philosophy* and the *International Society for Environmental Ethics*. In addition to contributed papers, the program will include leading figures in the field. The schedule (to be announced in Mid-March), will include:

- Plenary presentations on the evenings of June 1 and 2;
- 10 Presentations, with time for comments and discussion)
- Papers available beforehand on-line

The meeting will be held at 8500 feet at the Highlands Center, a recently constructed (2002) retreat center which includes rooms, meeting space, and a cafeteria. Longs Peak (elev. 14,000) hovers above the conference center and is within close hiking distance. Rooms are available at the Highlands Center ranging from \$90 singles to \$110 for 4. We have reserved 20 rooms, each of which comfortably house between 2 and 4 guests. (see http://www.highlandscamp.org/retreat_center.htm for further information).
