**Instructions** (delete instructions in blue before submittal):

2-page limit; single-spaced; 11-point Times New Roman; font in figures can be smaller than 11-point font, but must be readable; 1-inch margins; include at least one key graphic; include references/bibliography.

Include:

- a) Project goal, objectives, and possible outcomes
- b) Connection to and potential impacts for renewable energy science
- c) Research methods
- d) Schedule (identify either one or two years)
- e) Brief explanation of postdoctoral candidate-research mentor match
- f) Mutual benefit to US and Brazil, fit within CINEMA, and planned publications.

To the research statement, please add the following:

- 2) CV of Brazilian Applicant (no page limit)
- 3) Letter of Reference from Graduate School Advisor (limit: 1 page)
- 4) Letter of Reference from current Postdoctoral Advisor (limit: 1 page)
- 5) Letter of Reference from the person of your choice (limit: 1 page)
- 6) Letter of Commitment from Research Mentor (limit: 1 page)
