

Conducting Interviews



- Setting up the interview
 - Pre-interview: phone call, introduction, identify interviewee, expectations.
 - Refine questions: based on pre-interview, open-ended questions (e.g. "take me through a day in your life as...")
 - Find Location: indoors, outdoors, sound (avoid wind, air conditioners), lighting (don't put them in front of windows, avoid direct sunlight), chairs/standing (no rolling chairs)
 - Composition: rule of thirds, tripod





Conducting Interviews



- During interview

- Interviewer: remind interviewee to "repeat the question", engage with interviewee, follow-up questions (listen for when interviewee gets excited and ask questions about those topics/stories)
- Cameraperson: operate camera, move with person, monitor sound.
- Note-taker, follow-up questioner: take notes on interesting answers, good answers/content (saves time in editing), follow-up questions.
